
School Holidays


Cross Country Trials

Gabriella has worked very hard to get where she is and has come a long way. Congratulations Gabriella! We are all very proud of you.













Year 2 FAITH PAGE:

We have been learning: How and why do we develop our relationship with God through prayer?






















We are thrilled with the fantastic learning that has taken place this term at school. Our students have been engaged and motivated and making great progress across all areas.


First and foremost, our students have been working hard to deepen their understanding and appreciation of Jesus and our church.




We are incredibly proud of the progress our students have made this term, and we are looking forward to seeing their continued growth and development in term 2.
