This term year 1 have been learning all about the coming of Jesus.

We have been learning about the prophet Isaiah. We celebrated a grade liturgy to remind us that Jesus is coming. As we have recently entered the season of Advent, children have created their own Advent wreath and understand the significance of the evergreen leaves, the colour of the candles and the significance of waiting and preparing for the birth of Jesus. Each lesson we add a new candle to the wreath to signify the count down of Advent.



Matthew 2:1-11. We have learnt about the three wise men and why they were chosen to visit Jesus. As they were not Jews, God wanted to share that Jesus was a gift to everyone. We have discussed the relevance of gifts during Christmas and unpacked the 3 gifts the wise men gave Jesus.

Over the past two terms groups of students have been thoroughly enjoying participating in our Makerspace sessions. Infants have been busy building with Lego. Years 3 and 4 created Lego Wedo Robots and Years 5 and 6 learnt how to code Sphero robots and program them to race through custom made race courses!
