Students will be required to run the whole course and are strongly encouraged to wear adequate sun protection (sunscreen and school hat) and have a plentiful supply of water for hydration.

Parents, please note that this event is not compulsory but is open to any child who wishes to try out. Only students who are participating in the cross country event are permitted to wear their sports uniform on this day.




